




# The Story


# The Cast

IN 2005 HE FOUNDED WILD ROVER PRODUCTIONS, AN OHIO-BASED VIDEO PRODUCTION COMPANY THAT HE RUNS WHILE EDITING PINNED, HIS FEATURE DOCUMENTARY ON HIGH SCHOOL WRESTLING.

#### TRYSTA A. BISSETT - Writer




#### SEAN COLE - Producer




#### MIKE DEAS - Director of Photography

JONATHAN IS AN ALUMNUS OF OHIO UNIVERSITY, WHERE HE SPENT HIS TIME DOING TWO THINGS: EDITING AND MORE EDITING. WHILE IN COLLEGE, HE SHOT AND CUT PACKAGES FOR WOUB-TV, ATHENS, WHERE HE WORKED IN PROFESSIONAL NEWS PRODUCTION. AS A CO-FOUNDER OF WILD ROVER PRODUCTIONS, HE HAS COLLABORATED WITH DIRECTOR NORMAN AS AN EDITOR FOR NUMEROUS SHORT FILMS, INCLUDING TURBULENCE, MAYBE BY THEN, AND WHAT WOULD MACGUYVER DO.



# The Production

PEANUT BUTTER BEGAN AS PART OF "TCOM 419," AN ADVANCED NARRATIVE PRODUCTION CLASS AT OHIO UNIVERSITY'S SCRIPPS COLLEGE OF COMMUNICATION. IT WAS THERE THAT STUDENTS PATRICK NORMAN, JOHNNIE MAIER, AND SEAN COLE FELL IN LOVE WITH A CHARMING LITTLE SCRIPT BY ALUMNAE TRYSTA BISSETT.

AFTER A BRIEF PERIOD OF DEVELOPMENT, NORMAN, MAIER, AND COLE ASSEMBLED A TALENTED CREW OF FRIENDS AND FELLOW PRODUCTION STUDENTS TO BEGIN WORK ON WHAT THEY PLANNED WOULD BE THE MOST AMBITIOUS FILM YET MADE AT OHIO UNIVERSITY. WITH ONLY A SHOESTRING BUDGET RAISED BY SELLING MAGAZINES AND PLASMA, THE WORLD OF *PEANUT BUTTER* STARTED TO COME ALIVE.

BEFORE LONG, THE CREW HAD BUILT SETS FOR AN ENTIRE FAMILY HOUSE, STAGED A HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL GAME IN A REAL STADIUM WITH MORE THAN 175 EXTRAS, AND CLOSED DOWN 2 MILES OF HIGHWAY TO CAPTURE BREATHTAKING FOOTAGE FROM A HELICOPTER. ALL THIS, COMBINED WITH PROFESSIONAL ACTORS AND THE CUTEST CAT THE WORLD HAS EVER SEEN, GAVE THE FILMMAKERS THE POWER TO TELL THEIR STORY THE WAY IT NEEDED TO BE TOLD.









# The Production

THANKS TO AN ALL-DIGITAL POST PRODUCTION WORKFLOW DEVISED BY NORMAN AND FELLOW EDITOR JONATHAN FALK, THE FILM WAS ABLE TO BE CUT DURING ITS TEN-WEEKEND PRINCIPAL PHOTOGRAPHY PERIOD. THIS PROVIDED A STREAMLINED PROCESS FOR THE FILM TO BE LOCKED WITH VISUAL EFFECTS IN PLACE, MIXED, SCORED, AND COLOR GRADED IN A VERY SMALL PERIOD OF TIME.

JUST AS THE PROCESS OF MAKING THE FILM HAS COME TO AN END, NORMAN, MAIER, COLE, AND THE REST OF THE TREMENDOUSLY TALENTED CAST AND CREW OF *PEANUT BUTTER* END THE CYCLE AS THEY BEGAN IT: WITH AN HONEST, INNOCENT, AND FUNNY STORY THAT THEY BELIEVE WILL RESONATE WITH AUDIENCES AT FESTIVALS AND BEYOND.
